NOTES FROM THE LOFT June 7, 2015
MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST (Corpus Christi)

In the context of sacrifice, the word "blood" is mentioned no less than eleven times in the Readings and Sequence for next Sunday's solemnity, Corpus Christi. In the First Reading from the Book of Exodus, Moses sprinkles God's People, with the blood of a sacrificed bull, saying, "This is the BLOOD of the COVENANT that the Lord has made with you..." In every Mass, through the priest celebrant, Jesus, the new Moses, says, "This is the chalice of MY BLOOD, the BLOOD of the NEW and ETERNAL COVENANT which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins."

"BLOOD of my Savior, bathe me in Thy tide" is the third invocation of the beautiful prayer, ANIMA CHRISTI, or as it is known by its English title, SOUL OF MY SAVIOR. Its origins are disputed. It was richly indulgenced by Pope John XXII in 1330 but wrongly attributed to both him and St. Ignatius of Loyola. The Catholic Encyclopedia cites the research findings of the English hymnologist, James Mearns, who discovered it in a manuscript dating back to 1370. Another source points to a copy found in a library in Avignon, France, dating back to 1387, placing it at least one hundred years before Ignatius' birth.

The ANIMA CHRISTI is a perfect example of 'lex orandi, lex credendi' – the law of prayer is the law of belief. The invocations form a beautiful act of faith: "Soul of Christ, sanctify me. Body of Christ, save me. Blood of Christ, inebriate me. Water from the side of Christ, wash me." It has been set to music under both the Latin and English titles including SOUL OF MY SAVIOR by composer, organist and choir director, Rev. Louis Lambilotte, SJ, (1796-1855) and his contemporary, William Maher (1823-1877). Most recently a lovely setting, entitled ANIMA CHRISTI, has been introduced into this country from Italy, the work of Rev. Marco Frisina, Director of the Pastoral Worship Center at the Vatican. Choir music will include the works of Lambilotte, Maher and Frisina next Sunday.

MAKING ALL THINGS NEW



As part of long range planning in the process of *Making All Things New*, Cardinal Dolan established twelve ministry directives for each cluster within the Archdiocese to be prioritized and implemented. We belong to Cluster 51 which includes, Assumption in Peekskill, Holy Name of Mary in Croton-on-Hudson, Holy Spirit in Cortlandt Manor, Saint Columbus in Cortlandt Manor, Saint Christopher's in Buchanan which will merge with Saint Patrick's in Verplanck. The cluster representing these parishes have identified four priorities to be implemented in the next year.

- Plan and implement a common, cluster-wide evangelization program.
- Evaluate and develop strategies for enhancing lifelong faith formation for adults.
- Evaluate the need for a Sunday morning Spanish Mass within the Cluster
- Create or enrich collaborative youth and young adult ministry.

Other directives will be emphasized in subsequent years.

CORPUS CHRISTI



On Sunday, June 7 at 2:30pm, there will be a Solemn Mass in celebration of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi).

Following the Mass, there will be a Eucharistic (sidewalk) procession from the Church around the block through Peekskill. Along the way, there are 4 stops for prayer, song and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
