NOTES FROM THE LOFT

Sixth Sunday of Easter - The Music of Life & Love
 May 14, 2017

The operative word in next Sunday's Gospel is IF. "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments." And such wonderful things follow upon OBEDIENCE to that IF.

Jesus opens a floodgate of promises: "If you love Me (that is, if you keep My commandments), I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate...the Spirit of truth." "If you love Me (that is, if you keep My commandments), I will come to you." "If you love Me (that is, if you keep My commandments), you will SEE Me!" "If you love Me (that is, keep My commandments), you will LIVE!" "If you love Me (that is, keep My commandments), you will realize that I am in My Father, and you are in Me and I in you. Whoever...observes them...loves Me... (and) will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and reveal Myself to him."

Jesus tells us to bear fruit that will last. In the 4th century A.D. St. Gregory, bishop of Nyssa, Turkey, wrote of the connection between a faith-filled life, keeping the Commandments and bearing fruit. "The reign of life has begun...a new birth...a new life. Faith is the womb that conceives this new life, Baptism the rebirth by which it is brought forth. The Church is its nurse; her teachings...its milk; the Bread from Heaven...its Food. In this new creation, purity of life is the sun; virtues are the stars; goodness...the air. Sound doctrine... (and) divine teachings...(are) the grass and plants that feed God's flock. THE KEEPING OF THE COMMANDMENTS is the FRUIT borne by the trees."

"I will not leave you orphans," Jesus promises. Sixteenth-century English composer, Thomas Tallis, wrote the motet, IF YE LOVE ME, memorializing Jesus' words: "If ye love Me, keep My Commandments, and I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Comforter, the Spirit of TRUTH." (Jn.14:16)

Dr. Peter Latona, choir director at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Wash. DC., composed his hauntingly beautiful MANDATUM linking love with obedience. Contemporary songwriter, Michael Ward's A NEW COMMANDMENT also treats the theme but goes on to allay our fears of being orphaned with reference to the promised Spirit, our Consoler and Advocate. All three pieces will be sung at the Choir Mass next Sunday.

Though subjected to various forms of psychological pressure, Saint Thomas More refused to compromise, never forsaking the constant fidelity to legitimate authority and institutions which distinguished him; he taught by his life and his death that 'man cannot be separated from God, nor politics from morality.'"

BEHIND THE SCENES AT ASSUMPTION

It takes many people to see to it that a parish runs smoothly. In our continuing series highlighting parish employees and volunteers, we focus this week on Father John Higgins, our Pastor.



"As proud as I am to be the Pastor of Assumption Church, there is one thing I can say I am yet still prouder to be: the son of John and Bernadette (Shaughnessy) Higgins. Born in New York City, I am the younger brother of Vincent (Elizabeth) Higgins (married and

living in Houston, Texas) and the older brother of Regina (Erik) Syversen who lives with her eight children in Stanfordville, New York.

We grew up in Millbrook, New York, and attended Saint Joseph Elementary School there and later, Our Lady of Lourdes High School (class of 1986) in Poughkeepsie, New York. It was at Thomas Aquinas College in Santa Paula, California (class of 1990) where I discerned God's call the priesthood.

After working for a year to pay off student loans, I entered the seminary system of the Archdiocese of New York and was ordained a priest on May 11, 1996. Shortly after ordination, Cardinal O'Connor sent seven of us to study Spanish in the Dominican Republic. I have served in three parishes as a priest: Holy Rosary in the Bronx (1996-2002), Saint Gregory Barbarigo in Garnerville, New York (2002-2005) and Church of the Assumption in Peekskill (2005 until present).

When I first came to Assumption, I served as Parochial Vicar under the great Msgr. Ansbro. On the 100th anniversary of the first time the Guardian Building was used, October 1, 2006, I became the 21st Pastor.

It has been a humbling honor to have a front row seat in seeing the things that God has been doing in this parish. What an amazing place! I would like to thank Assumption parishioners and staff for making it such a joyful and inspiring place to serve as a priest.
