**NOTES FROM THE LOFT**

**Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**July 16, 2017**

Next Sunday's Gospel about the sower and the seed is as well-known as the parable of the prodigal son. Jesus' listeners lived with deserts and droughts, with farming and famine and understood all too well the difference between rain and ruin.

The First Reading from Isaiah connects the dots between precipitation, fertility of the soil, and the seed which produces bread for the table. The Psalm speaks to the farmer who gives thanks to God who has "visited the land and watered it." Water – a most precious commodity – fills the "watercourses"; "drenching" the "furrows", "softening" the land with "showers". The year is bountiful; the harvest rich; the meadows and hill, the fields and valleys are "garmented" with produce and flocks!

Isaiah's mention of the rain and snow that come down from Heaven, which in time yield bread, are Advent and Eucharistic themes. In Advent, we sing "Drop down dew from Heaven...let the earth open and salvation bud forth." (Is.45:8) Moreover, there are subtle prophecies about Christ in the Psalm's references to the "WORD...that goes forth from My mouth; My WORD...shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it." JESUS is the Word, and His Gospel is the seed which falls on all kinds of soil. Jesus is the Savior who shepherds the flocks, and the Bread come down from Heaven which gives life.

LITANY OF THE WORD (Litany for Advent)# 66 addresses Jesus as the Word of justice, mercy, power and freedom. The response 'Alleluia' derives from the Aramaic 'hallel' and 'yahu' – Praise the Lord! 'Maranatha' (marana-tha) is Aramaic for "Come, Lord!"

AS WE GATHER AT YOUR TABLE # 311 (1989 lyrics) is set to the "Nettleton", an anonymous American tune first published in 1813 and originally called "Hallelujah". It was eventually named for a well-known 19<sup>th</sup> century evangelist, Asahel Nettleton. We also sing it with the 1982 lyrics, GOD, WE PRAISE YOU, which are a modern translation of the "Te Deum Lauda-mus" of St. Nicetas (335-414 AD).

OPEN MY EYES # 390 and BE THOU MY VISION # 394 round out the Choir's program with an invitation to be receptive to God's word, to share it and to live it.

"All [the clients] were told about the procedure itself was that they would experience slight cramping similar to menstrual cramps, and that was it. ## BLESSING OF CARS IN HONOR OF SAINT CHRISTOPHER



Whatever happened to Saint Christopher? Many people have asked if he stopped being a saint. The answer: No! After the liturgical reforms of the Sacred Vatican Council, the list of saints celebrated by the entire Church was "purified"; because many stories about saint Christopher have not been verified historically, he is no longer celebrated on the universal Church calendar. He is, however, still celebrated as a saint in the United States (feast day July 25) and, in honor of his being the patron saint of travelers, we will have our annual blessing of the cars after the 10:00am Mass on **Sunday, July 23**. As each car exits the parking lot, priests will be available to bless each vehicle and sprinkle it with holy water.

## HEALING MASS

Assumption invites all in need of healing to a Healing Mass on **Wednesday, July 26, at 7:00PM**. The evening will initiate at 6:30pm with the prayer of the Rosary. 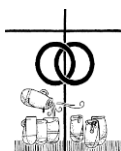
### SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO
