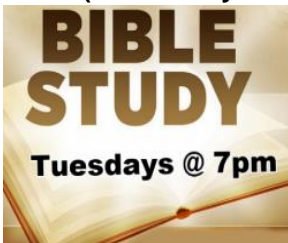
A VERY SPECIAL HEALING MASS

Our Lord Jesus often used psalms to explain his teachings and strengthen the faith of his people. They express the yearnings of the heart, giving us hope and courage in times of struggle and drawing us into a deeply personal encounter with God.

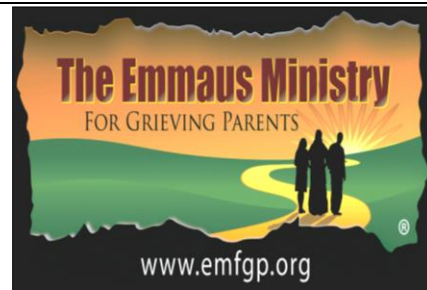
Small group discussions will be led by dedicated facilitators. Coffee and tea will be provided. The \$40 fee includes a study guide and access to DVDs.

PROGRAMA DE CONVALIDACIÓN

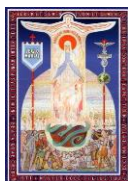
