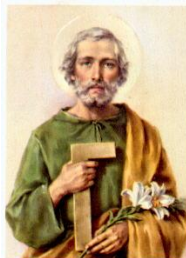

DEACON KAREEM SMITH – PRIEST TO BE

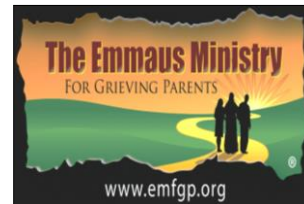
